Clinical Marvels

ONE OF THE RARE CONGENITAL HEART DISEASE, SUCCESSFULLY TREATED

Patient with Partial Anomalous Pulmonary Venous Connection (PAPVC) treated successfully at Sanar International Hospitals

elay in the treatment of congenital heart disease results in restricted growth and multiple health issues in adult age, but in one of the rare cardiac cases treated, it was found that the patient's congenital heart disease was undiagnosed for more than 45 years until at the age of 48 years when he started experiencing severe breathlessness.

48-years-old Mr. Hilal from Iraq visited Sanar International Hospitals with complaints of severe 'Breathlessness on Exertion' (BOE). After evaluation, the reports suggested that he had a rare birth defect of heart called Partial Anomalous


Pulmonary Venous Connection (PAPVC). His condition was rarest of rare and is found in less than one in a million new born children, surprisingly, it went undiagnosed during his childhood and a large part of his adult life.



The usual Concomitant ASD found in the heart with this anomaly, was missing in his heart. Adding to the rarity of the case, he was also suffering from Bronchial Asthma, and the Right Superior Pulmonary Vein (RSPV) which connects lungs to the left heart could have affected his respiratory system as well. His condition was worsening with every passing day and immediate surgery was the only solution to improve his health.

Under the experienced supervision of Dr. Akhil Govil, Director and HOD, Cardiac Surgery, a surgery was planned with all the necessary precautions considering his health condition and other associated co-morbidities. The Atrial Septal Defect (ASD) was manually created by surgeons and cow pericardium was used to create the tunnel from RSPV to ASD. The entire procedure was performed in 5 long hours with an uneventful post-operative recovery of the patient.

Dr. Govil said, "Our heart is one of the most delicate and vital organs of our body and any minor defect can turn out to be life threatening, if not treated and managed in time. Mr. Hilal's condition was discovered at a very late stage and could have proved to be fatal at any point of his life. The day Mr. Hilal reported in our hospital, his condition was very severe, and if the procedure was not done timely, the breathlessness could have created unbearable pressure on his heart with



every passing day, which could have led to further worsening of his condition. Now Mr. Hilal can continue with his daily routine work with timely follow-ups and healthy lifestyle. It is indeed very satisfying to see a patient regain his normal life after a successful surgery."

Sharing his happiness Mr. Hilal said, "We had complete faith in the medical and surgical team of Sanar International Hospitals, Gurugram. A big thank you to all the doctors and staff at the hospital for giving me a new lease of life."

A MULTIDISCIPLINARY CARE APPROACH WORKED WONDERS

Neurosurgery and Bariatric Surgery helped Ms. Akhtamova walk again

s. Tursunkhon Akhtamova from Tajikistan could not get her condition diagnosed appropriately in her native country, and was almost wheelchair bound. She arrived at Sanar International Hospitals morbidly obese with diabetes, and hypertension. When evaluated thoroughly, she had severe spine issues with her BMI twice the normal, and weakness in both her knees.

Under the expert guidance of Dr. Harnarayan Singh, Director and HOD - Neurosurgery and Spine Surgery, Ms. Akhtamova underwent a spine surgery that went on for four hours, where her spine was successfully decompressed at two levels.

She also underwent a successful Minimal Invasive Laparoscopic Bariatric Surgery to help her with the diabetes and obesity issue, by a team of specialists led by Dr. Vinay Shaw, HOD and Senior Consultant Gl, Minimal Access and Bariatric Surgery.

Ms. Akhtamova started showing signs of improvement and was discharged from the hospital in four days' time. In the post-surgery treatment plan, she started on physiotherapy and rehabilitation programme, and was able to walk very well by the end of two weeks.

With teary eyes, Ms. Akhtamova stated, "For the last five years, I was not able to walk properly, I had to take the

support of a walker even in my room. I had multiple disc herniation and myelopathy. My legs were extremely cold and I was not able to sense them. When I arrived at Sanar International Hospitals and after Dr. Harnarayan Singh had performed one of the surgeries, I actually felt my legs and started walking the very next day.

I am very thankful to Dr. Vinay Shaw as well, as he advised me for a bariatric surgery, that helped with my obesity and diabetes, and bringing down my sugar level to normal. I am very grateful to Sanar International Hospitals for taking such good care, and helping me walk again normally."
